

- Have you had a carer's assessment?
- Do you know what a carer's assessment is?
- Do you know how it can benefit you?

The carer's assessment will look at support, preventative services, whether a carer works or wishes to do so and if a carer wants to participate in education, training or any leisure activity.

An assessment gives you the chance to:

- Think about your needs
- Consider the impact of caring on your 'well-being'
- Talk, in private, to someone who understands your situation
- Be listened to
- Think about whether you feel you can go on caring and the choices you have
- Talk about the support you think is important to carry out your role and to maintain your health and well being

Have your voice listened to!

The Parents Federation speaks up for family carers to make sure they are not overlooked. We are run by volunteer parent trustees and others, who knows what being a carer involves. YOUR QUESTIONS ANSWERED?

Why should I become a trustee?

Do you want to make a difference? Do you want your voice heard as well as other parents? If you answered yes to those two questions then being a trustee could be for you. You play a vital role in a sector that contributes significantly to the character and wellbeing of the country

What do you do?

As a Cardiff & Vale Parents Fed trustee you will give parents a voice. You will ensure that the charity is meeting its goals and focus on what should be prioritised this year.

I don't have any experience?

You do not need to have board level experience to become a trustee. You do not need to be a specialist to be valuable. If you apply fresh perspective, commitment, and a bit of common sense, you'll be doing a good job.

I don't have time?

At Cardiff and Parent's Federation we only need you to attend trustee meetings four times a year. If you want to do more then we will not stop you but that is the minimum requirement.

What do I need to know?

No experience is needed, we will give full training. You will develop transferable skills, improve your CV, and broaden your experience. You will meet a wide range of new people which could open doors to all sorts of other networks and opportunities. Have the chance to shape, support and contribute your ideas and knowledge to a meaningful cause and organisations.

Is it Voluntary?

Yes but you will get expenses paid.

Don't forget anyone can be a trustee - you experience as a carer matters the most.
