Transitions – making changes

We are seeking families to help us with our transitions project. The project aims to identify gaps in current service provision as well as helping to identify ways in which opportunities could be developed. We shall have a detailed information resource held online once we have collated everything but it will only be as good as the information that people share with us.

If your child is approaching their teens or as an adult seeking to move from the family home, <u>we need to know what support you feel is needed</u>. We can then ensure that the local authorities and other professionals involved in supporting your child (or adult relative) are made aware of what matters to them and you!

Direct payments

The Parents Federation recently had new neighbours join us at our Fairwater office base.

<u>Dewis</u> are a local charity that supports people to use Direct Payments amongst other things, offer a free service to families who are considering using Direct payments to pay for all or part of their support.

They can help take a lot of the hassle and uncertainty out of using Direct payments and have a team of staff to offer face to face information, assistance and support.

Have you had a carers' assessment recently?

If you currently care for someone or expect to then you are a carer!

Did you know that carers are entitled to an assessment of your needs by your local authority? Sadly, many carers aren't aware of this and cope in isolation when they may be eligible for support. Caring can have a huge impact on all aspects of your life, so you should receive a council assessment to see how they can help you.

You can ask for an assessment from your local council at any time. You can find out more about carers' assessments in Cardiff <u>here</u> and in the Vale of Glamorgan <u>here</u>.

Even if you are sure that you will not be eligible for financial support it is worth applying as you will be kept informed of any non means tested opportunities as well as kept abreast of information on your rights and changes in the law for carers – you may be surprised to see the assistance available to you.

The Parents Federation supports carers across Cardiff & the Vale. We work with local authorities and other third sector partners to inform carers of what is happening in the region. We are run by and for unpaid family carers.

We are currently recruiting a new team of trustees and looking for carers to get involved.
